Background

The Government is encouraging local authorities to appoint a Historic Environment Champion within their management structures.

English Heritage have therefore produced a Guidance Note setting out in some detail what Historic Environment Champions might do and achieve.

They are also developing a programme of training opportunities and events to assist such champions to network and share best practice.

A copy of the Guidance Note is attached.

It will be noticed that there is reference in the note to the relationship between Historic Environment and Design Champions.

For Members' information the Council's Design Champion is Mr R Wilson the Local Plans Manager.
