

THE SECOND SCHEDULE

Conditions For The Issue of Long-Stay Parking Permits

1. The applicant will be the permit holder who shall certify that they are the owner of, or an employee of a business with premises in one of the following Town centre/ shopping areas:
 - Arnold
 - Carlton Hill
 - Carlton Square
 - Mapperley

As defined on the plans attached to these conditions.

2. The permit holder may park one vehicle lawfully displaying a permit in any of Gedling Borough Council's Pay and Display car parks only. The car parks referred to are set out in The First Schedule Part I of The Gedling Borough Council (????) Order 200?.
3. The permit does not guarantee a parking space will be available at any time.
4. The fee for the permit will be as described in the council schedule of charges for pay and display.
5. The permit will display the month and year of expiry with a unique reference number.
6. Failure to display a current permit, may lead to a charge being made in accordance with the Articles of the Gedling Borough Council (????) Order 200?.
7. Failure to comply with the Articles of the Gedling Borough Council (????) Order 200? may also lead to the withdrawal of parking rights, loss of permit and ineligibility for further issue of a permit for a period of one year. No balance of the fee will be repayable
8. Any misuse of the permit may, upon the serving of a Notice, render the permit invalid and no balance of the fee will be repayable.
9. Existing permit holders will have the right to renew their permit. New permits will be issued on a first come first served basis. If the number of applicants exceeds the number of permits available then one permit will be issued for each of the business premises. Then a second where applied for and so on, with the date of receipt of the application being the deciding factor. If all the permits have been issued, any remaining or new applicants shall be placed on a waiting list until such time as a permit becomes available.
10. Permits are not vehicle specific and may be transferred between vehicles. A permit entitles the holder to park **one** vehicle in any **one** qualifying car park at a time. Any attempt to duplicate a permit or in any other way circumvent this clause will be treated as misuse of the permit (See Cl 8)_
