Annex G – WasteDataFlow Reporting Responsibilities

It is imperative that Waste Data Flow is completed on a timely basis, in order that the County does not receive fines from DEFRA. Districts therefore will complete their own Waste Data Flow entries, and have it authorised up to level 30 by the following dates;

Period One – April to June by 30th September Period Two – July to September by 31st December Period Three – October to December by 31st March Period Four – January to March by 30th June

Seven days before the end of that periods Waste Data Flow submission, the Districts will provide the County with an accurate tonnage of their commercial waste collected, to enable the WDA to make its Waste Data Flow submission by the dates detailed above.

Failure of a District to meet the dates above, could incur a penalty charge (fine) to the County from DEFRA. Any fines incurred would be invoiced to the relevant district as outlined in the financial framework in annex B.

Districts should endeavour to send a nominated representative to each of the Waste Data Flow User Group held quarterly.
