Parking Permits

31. Parking Permits are available from the Council at the appropriate fee, for a Vehicle of a Specific class and for a specific Parking Place subject to terms and conditions determined by the Council.

32. The driver shall abide by the terms and conditions stipulated by the Council for the use of the Parking Permit.

33. A Parking Permit is only valid in the Parking Place in respect of which it was issued and up to the date of expiry shown on the Parking Permit.
34. A Parking Permit remains the property of the Council and must be surrendered on request. In such instances where a refund fee is appropriate this will be provided in accordance with the Council's policies and procedures.

Displaying of Parking Permit

35. The driver of the Vehicle shall display the Parking Permit in the Relevant Position on the Vehicle in respect of which it was issued at all times during which the Vehicle is left in the Parking Place.

Replacement Parking Permits

36. Damaged or lost Parking Permits will be replaced on application to the Council and on payment of an administration fee (if charged). The damaged or lost Parking Permit will then become immediately invalid.

Surrender of Parking Permit

37. The holder of a Parking Permit shall on surrendering the Parking Permit be entitled to a refund based upon the number of complete months remaining unexpired from the beginning of the calendar month following the date on which the Council received the surrendered Parking Permit less an administration fee.

Restriction on Removal

38. When a Parking Permit has been exhibited on a Vehicle in the Relevant Position no person shall remove the Parking Permit from the Vehicle until the Vehicle is removed from the Parking Place.

PART IV

EXEMPTIONS FROM CHARGES

39. No charge (if any required) shall be payable in respect of;
 - (i) a Vehicle which displays in the relevant position a valid Disabled Person's Badge provided that the Vehicle has been used or is about to be used by the person(s) in respect of whom the badge is issued immediately before or immediately after the Vehicle was parked in the Parking Bay.
 - (ii) a Motorcycle which is left in a parking bay specified for such Vehicles (if any); or
 - (iii) a Vehicle left displaying in a relevant position a valid Parking Permit valid for that Parking Place.
