1. PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

To inform Members of a request received for a nomination to the combined Gedling Parochial Charities Board and JW Harris Charity.

2. BACKGROUND

The Gedling Parochial Charities Board administers a sum of around £500 per year and, by working through six local schools, provides small grants to enable young people in need to take up extra - curricular development.

The Board also administers the JW Harris Charity, which is a legacy from a local businessman. The Board meet in March to approve the accounts and in October to approve grants.

The Secretary has contacted the Council seeking a new nomination.

3. PROPOSAL

The Labour Group Business Manager has proposed that Councillor Wheeler is nominated to represent the Council on this board.

4. RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that members approve the nomination of Councillor Wheeler to the Gedling Parochial Charities Board and JW Harris Charity.
