The Nottingham & District Citizens Advice Bureau is a registered charity that relies heavily on volunteer advisers, information assistants, administrators and trustee board members.

Positions on the Board are available to Nottinghamshire County Council, Nottingham City Council, Gedling Borough Council and Rushcliffe Borough Council. The organisation receives grant aid from each of these bodies and delivers advice, information and representation services to residents of south Nottinghamshire.

The Board meets on a quarterly basis.
