1. PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

To inform Members of a request received for a nomination to the PATROL (Parking and Traffic Regulations Outside London) Joint Committee.

2. BACKGROUND

The PATROL Adjudication Joint Committee, formerly the National Parking Adjudication Service Joint Committee, was established to enable Councils having Civil Enforcement Area Orders to exercise their functions under Section 81 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and Regulations 17 and 18 of the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007. These functions are exercised jointly with the other councils in accordance with the requirements of Regulation 16 of the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007.

3. PROPOSAL

The Labour Group Business Manager has proposed that Councillor Key is nominated to represent the Council on this committee.

4. RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that members approve the nomination of Councillor Key to the PATROL (Parking and Traffic Regulations Outside London) Joint Committee.
