COMMITTEE REPORT DECEMBER 2012

Housing Act 2004 Section 16 Revocation

Following the completion of works a Notice was served on the owner of a property on Villiers Road, Woodthorpe on 30th October 2012 revoking the improvement notice served on the same property on 27th April 2011.

Housing Act 2004 Section 11

A Notice was served on the owner of a property on Gunthorpe Road, Gedling on 14th November 2012, requiring that works be carried out to the floor in the bathroom due to a wood worm infestation

HEALTH & SAFETY AT WORK ETC ACT 1974

A Prohibition Notice was served on the owner of premises in Hallams Lane, Arnold on 26th October 2012 prohibiting the use of sterilising equipment to prevent the spread of blood borne viruses.

Food Hygiene (England) Regulations 2006 EC852/2004

Five Hygiene Improvement Notices were served on a food business operator of a business on Victoria Road, Netherfield following an investigation into pest activity in the area. The business was voluntarily closed for seven days whilst refurbishment works were carried out. The premises were awarded a hygiene rating score of one at the last routine inspection in May 2012.

Environmental Protection Act 1990 sections 87 and 88

Under the above legislation it is an offence if any person throws down, drops or otherwise deposits litter on any public land. The Act also enables the local Authority to operate a fixed penalty scheme whereby the offender may be given the option for paying a fixed penalty within 14 days and so discharge any liability of conviction for that offence by the Court. The current level of fixed penalty is £50.00.
