COMMITTEE REPORT MAY 2013

Environmental Protection Act 1990 Section 80

A Notice was served on the occupier of a property on Foxhall Road Central, Carlton on 13th March 2013, to prevent a dog barking at the property from causing statutory noise nuisance.

A Notice was served on the occupier of a property on Hodgkinson Street, Netherfield on 20th March 2013, to cease, or cause other persons at the property to cease playing music at such a volume to cause statutory noise nuisance.

A Notice was served on the occupier of a property on Third Avenue, Carlton on 23rd March 2013, to prevent an accumulation of domestic and garden waste at the front of the property.

Health & Safety at Work Etc Act 1974 Section 22, 23, and 24

A Prohibition Notice was served on the tenant and Manager of a property on Front Street, Arnold on 27th March 2013, to prevent the use of the CMA Electrically Heated Café Boiler with associated safety valve, pressure gauge and high temperature cut-out, so as not to cause injury to any persons at the premises. The Notices were complied with and the boiler is now safely back in use.

Food Hygiene (England) Regulations 2006 Regulation 17 (1)

Two Notices were served on the owner of a property on Main Street, Burton Joyce on 26th March 2013, to take measures needed to comply with the Regulations, to ensure provision of documented food hygiene management system and to ensure that food handlers are supervised and instructed in food hygiene matters.

Housing Act 2004 Section 11 & 12

An Improvement Notice was served on the owner of a property on Carlton Hill, Carlton on 19th April 2013, to take remedial action to improve the premises to an acceptable standard, the works should be completed by the 17th September 2013.

Environmental Protection Act 1990 sections 87 and 88

Under the above legislation it is an offence if any person throws down, drops or otherwise deposits litter on any public land. The Act also enables the local Authority to operate a fixed penalty scheme whereby the offender may be given the option for paying a fixed penalty within 14 days and so discharge any liability of conviction for that offence by the Court. The current level of fixed penalty is £50.00.

The Dogs (Fouling of Land) Act 1996

Under the above legislation it is an offence if any person allows their dog to foul and not clear it away forthwith. Information for members

Fly tipping Section 33 EPA 1990

Fly tipping is the act of depositing waste in or on any land that does not have a Waste Management license that permits the deposit. The definition of waste is simply any substance or object that the holder discards (Throwing away waste on land that doesn't have a permit or permission)

Duty of Care Section 34 EPA 1990

Duty of care is a legal duty on anyone who imports, produces, carries, keeps or disposes of controlled waste, to ensure that waste is transferred only to an authorised person such as a local authority, a registered carrier or a licensed disposer. (Residents must ensure that if they pass waste onto anyone (with or without payment) they must ensure that they check for a waste carrier's license to comply with their duty)
