2. APPLICATION BY INTERESTED PARTIES FOR A REVIEW OF PREMISES LICENCE – TOBY JUG PUBLIC HOUSE 330-332 CARLTON HILL, CARLTON, NOTTINGHAM

After consideration it was:-

RESOLVED:

The decision of the Licensing Panel (in exercise of its powers delegated by Gedling Borough Council as Licensing Authority) was:

To **modify** the Conditions in Annex 3 as follows

i Clear, prominent, reasonably permanent and legible notices are to be provided in 3 areas of the car park and on all external doors-asking customers to leave quietly and respect the rights of neighbours.

ii The Landlord to monitor sound levels, 3 times nightly, both internally and externally (including up to no. 20 Cornhill Road, Carlton), when Regulated Entertainment is being provided. The Landlord is to ensure the reduction of sound levels where they appear to be too loud.

iii. On the First Tuesday of January, April, July and October, there shall be a meeting between the Landlord and the local residents, to be held at the Toby Jug Public House. The first meeting is to be held on Tuesday 3 October 2006.

iv. The windows and external doors of the Public House are to be kept closed, and the windows locked, when Regulated Entertainment is being provided.

v. The Landlord is to ensure the Acts providing the Regulated Entertainment stop the regulated entertainment at 23.00.
