4. APPLICATION FOR A PREMISES LICENCE TESCO – 712 – 716 MANSFIELD ROAD WOODTHORPE

RESOLVED:

That the decision of the Licensing Panel (in exercise of its powers delegated by Gedling Borough Council as Licensing Authority) was to grant the application for a new premises licence subject to the following conditions:-

Conditions.

i Those mandatory conditions imposed under Part 3 of the Licensing Act 2003 details of which will be listed in Annex 1 of the premises licence; and

ii Those conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule details of which will be listed in Annex 2 of the premises licence/club premises certificate;

iii The conditions attached after the hearing of the Licensing Authority detailed as follows, which will be listed in Annex 3 of the premises licence/club premises certificate

Annex 3 conditions:

1. Adequate Security will be arranged at the premises at the Police request, if it is believed events/incidents are taking place which may directly or indirectly impact on the safety of staff and customers
2. All staff will be fully trained in and support an approved 'challenge 21' proof of age scheme

3. Use of CCTV inside and outside the premises. This will be a digital; system with high quality colour cameras installed in positions as agreed with the Police but in any event to include at least 1 camera to cover the rear of the building.
4. No white cider/high volume products to be sold from the premises
5. Regular meetings are to be arranged by Tesco with local residents; to be held a minimum of 4 times a year with the first meeting being held within 3 months of the opening of the store. The regularity of the meetings to be reviewed by the parties after 12 months.
