Annex 3 Conditions:

1. All external doors and windows as shown in the submitted plan are to be closed, except for access and egress, when entertainment is being provided.

2. The management are to monitor external noise levels.

3. Clear, prominent and legible notice are to be provided at all internal exits asking customers to leave the premises and the area quietly and respect the rights of neighbours

4. Set up a meeting with local residents as soon as convenient to both parties.
