Reasons for Decision

The Panel have heard oral evidence and read written evidence from the Applicant, Interested Parties and Premises Licence Holder. They have also considered the written representations contained within the prepared bundle. They feel that;

Given the overwhelming number of residents in attendance today, indicating their support of the status quo and the number of residents living in proximity to the clubhouse who have no objection to the noise levels it would be disproportionate to alter the current premises Licence in any way.

Following the evidence heard, the Panel feel the activities in the club are appropriate to its location and noise levels are reasonable in the circumstances.

It is also felt that the licence holder is already taking reasonable steps to ensure that the noise levels do not amount to a public nuisance.
