1. Purpose of the Report

The Licensing Section has received a request from a licensed driver to advertise another of his businesses on his licensed hackney carriage vehicle. 2. Background

The Authority's Hackney Carriage Licence Conditions state the following:

4. ADVERTISEMENTS

- A Any advertisement on the vehicle shall be confined to a notice fixed to any of the side door panels of the vehicle containing the following information:-
 - (i) Name of Operator and
 - (ii) Telephone number of Operator.

The design of the notices shall be approved by the Council.

B No other advertising material shall be exhibited on the vehicle without the prior written approval of the Council's Environment and Licensing Committee.

3. Proposal

To request Members to consider giving written approval for the licensed driver to advertise his business on his licensed hackney carriage vehicle in accordance with the vehicle licence conditions.

Subject: Request to be exempt from displaying fixed plates – Mr John

Fletcher

1. Purpose of the Report

Mr Fletcher has requested the Committee to consider granting exemption to him from displaying fixed plates on vehicles licensed by him as he only undertakes executive private hire.

2. Background

Section 75(3) of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976 gives the Council the authority to waive the requirement to display vehicle licence plates. It follows that the driver can then be exempt from wearing the badge. This is often used in relation to vehicles that provide chauffeur services. Instead the Council can issue a notice which will be permanently displayed at all times inside any licensed vehicles owned or operated by Mr Fletcher.

3. Proposal

To grant an exemption to Mr Fletcher to allow his vehicles to be licensed without the requirement for the displaying of a licence plate.

4. Resource Implications

5. Recommendation

- a) With respect to Mr Fletcher the requirement to display vehicle licence plates is waived; and
- b) The Council issue a notice which will be permanently displayed at all times, in a position to be agreed, inside any licensed vehicles used for executive private hire purposes, owned or operated by Mr Fletcher.
