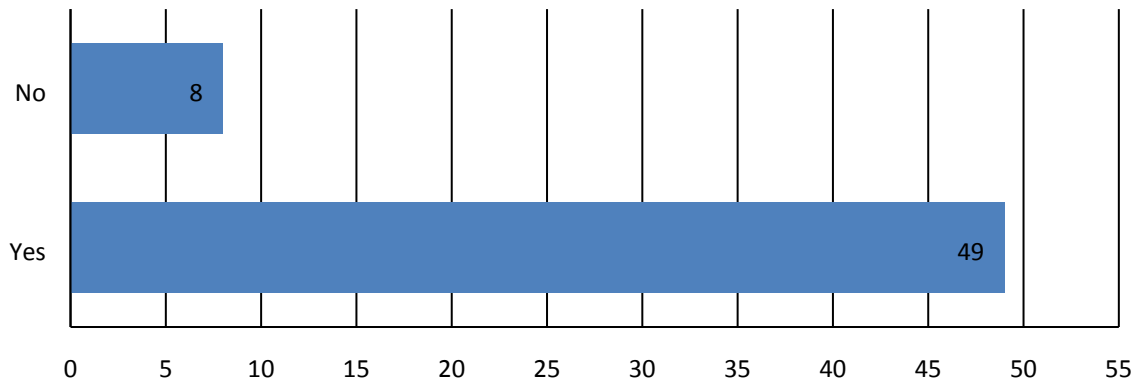


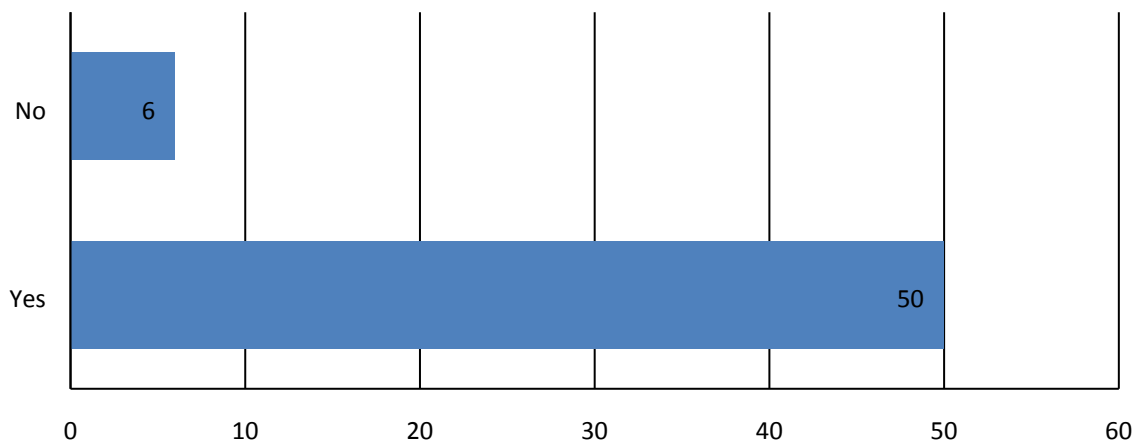

- Remove all parish councils

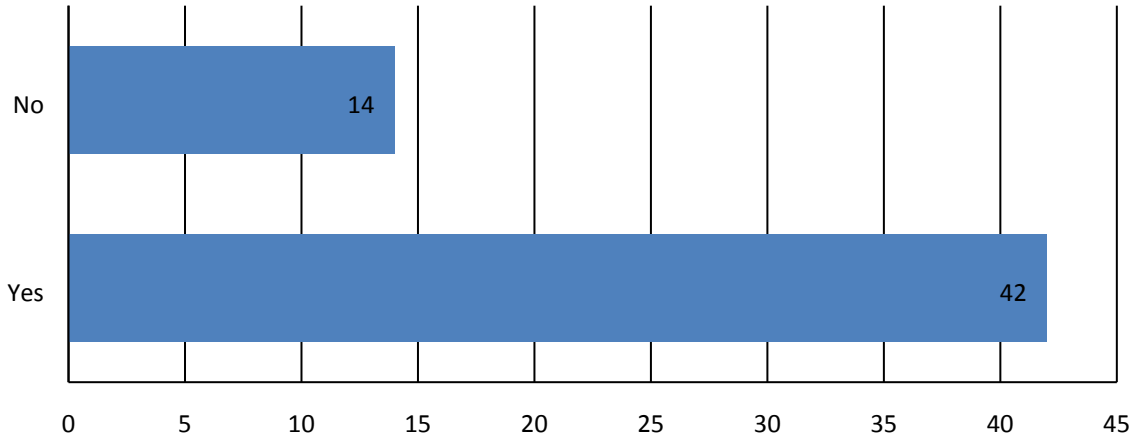
2. Do you agree that the new parish for the Bestwood Village Area being named Bestwood Village Parish Council?

- One suggestion of “Bestwood Pit Village Parish Council”

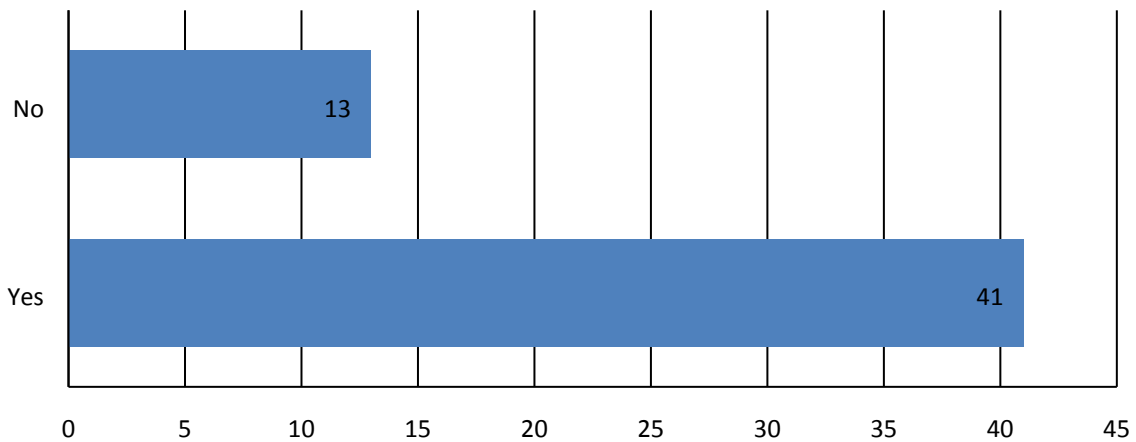
3. Do you agree that the new parish for the Bestwood Village Area being named St Albans Parish Council?



Summary of comments made under “If ‘No’ what should it be called?”

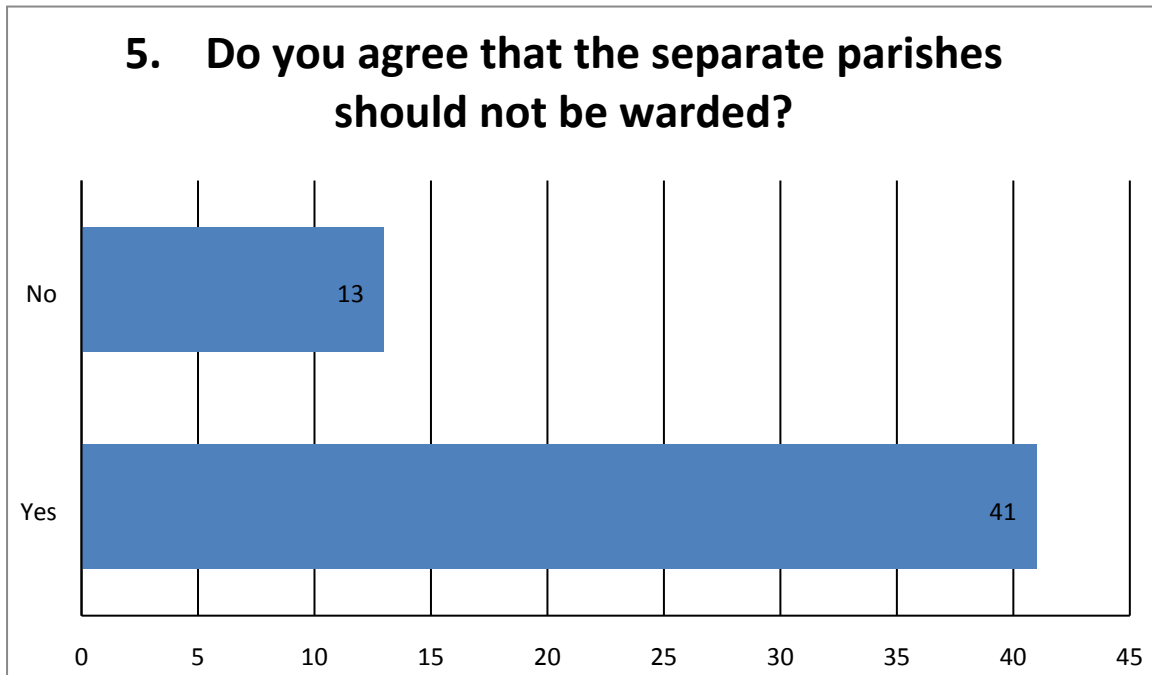
- Top Valley/Warren Hill Parish Council

Summary of comments made under “if ‘No’ what would you suggest?”

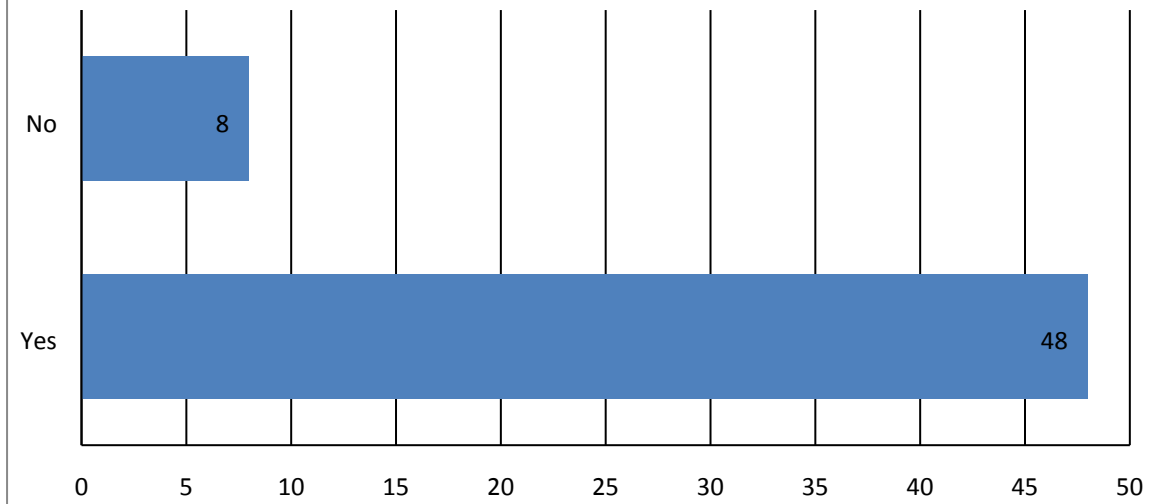
- 7 per council

Summary of comments made under “do you have any additional comments for the review”

- This is the best solution, the two areas are different and have differing needs
- Would be good to include the area of Bestwood Village covered by Ashfield District Council
- No more politicians on the “gravy train”
- General concern about a split resulting in an inability to “reclaim percept money from Village and spend it in the Top Valley area”
- The Review was a waste of taxpayer’s money.

Consultation summary

Total of 57 responses received

52 from electors in the parish / 5 were from residents outside of the parish.

Response rate to survey was 1.3% of the eligible electorate.
