

# Report to Council

**Subject:** Independent Remuneration Panel

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# 1. Purpose of the Report

To inform Council of the latest report from the Council's Independent Remuneration Panel and invite Council to consider the recommendations made by the Panel in that report.

### 2. Background

The Council's Independent Remuneration Panel met in December 2013 to carry out its annual review of members' allowances.

Following that meeting, the Panel prepared a report to members with regard to the level of members' allowances to be payable for 2014/15.

# 3. Proposal

Should Council be minded to accept the Panel's recommendations, then the level of allowances to be paid to members for 2014/15 will be as set out at **Appendix 2**.
