1 Background

- 1.1 On 8 June 2023, cabinet approved the making of a Public Space Protection Order to come into effect on 23rd June 2023. Details of the decision can be found here: [Agenda for Cabinet on Thursday 8 June 2023, 2.00 pm \(gedling.gov.uk\)](#)
- 1.2 Since this meeting, a slight drafting error has been identified in the Order, and whilst the area to which the Order applies is shown on the plan attached to the order, the Order itself should also be clear as to the area affected.
- 1.3 This amendment does not change the effect of the order as agreed by Cabinet on the 8th June 2023 it is purely an administrative amendment.

2 Proposal

- 2.1 It is proposed that a slight amendment to the PSPO is agreed to provide clarity within the Order as to the “Restricted Area”, which reflects the area delineated in the plan already agreed and attached to the Order.

3 Alternative Options

- 3.1 The Order is not amended. Whilst this would not make the current PSPO unlawful, it would not be as clear.
