Subject: Changes to Outside Body Appointments

1. Purpose of the Report

For Council to consider changes to outside bodies as detailed in the report.

2. Background

- 2.1 At the annual meeting, Council approved the appointment to outside bodies for the 2014/15 year. Since the appointments were made Members' Services have been advised of two changes that need to made.
- 2.2 The Parking and Traffic Regulations Outside London (PATROL) body has been in touch to advise that it requires a Councillor to be appointed as Gedling's representative. For the 2013/14 and 2012/13 years an officer appointment was made because it was considered that a high degree of technical expertise was required. In light of the contact from PATROL, the Labour Group has nominated Councillor Marje Paling to be the Council's representative.
- 2.3 The Labour Group has requested a change to the Council's representative on the Nottinghamshire Health and Wellbeing Board. It is proposed that Councillor Jenny Hollingsworth is replaced by Councillor Henry Wheeler as the Council's representative. It is proposed that Councillor John Clarke remains as the reserve member.

3. Proposal

It is recommended that Councillor Jenny Hollingsworth is replaced by Councillor Henry Wheeler as the Council's representative on the Nottinghamshire Health and Wellbeing Board and that Councillor Marje Paling is appointed as the Council's representative on the Parking and Traffic Regulations Outside London body.

It is recommended that:

- 1) Councillor Jenny Hollingsworth is replaced by Councillor Henry Wheeler as the Council's representative on the Nottinghamshire Health and Wellbeing Board; and
- 2) Councillor Marje Paling is appointed to be the Council's representative on the Parking and Traffic Regulations Outside London body.
