1. Purpose

The report outlines the 2024/25 fees and charges for Leisure Centres and seeks approval for their introduction from 1st April 2024.

3 Background

3.1 Financial Background

The communities and leisure department continues to critically review all operations to ensure that the most cost effective and efficient services are provided to the residents of the borough. The objective of maximising income within the social aims of the council remains a key focus as we strive to operate a discretionary service at the lowest level of subsidy possible whilst retaining service levels and standards.

With Portfolio Holder approval discretion can be made to apply varying

percentage increases to relevant fees and charges as long as the overall cash amount for that area is met. This allows consideration to be made for factors that influence the rate at which fees and charges are set.

These factors include:

- The borough's priorities.
- Comparative prices of neighbouring authorities
- Performance trends and individual activity price sensitivity.
- The cost benefit of the service.

3.2 **Price Comparisons**

Wherever possible pricing comparisons have been gathered from neighbouring authorities and are detailed in Appendix A. It should be noted that these are current year prices (23/24) and are subject to increase by the individual authorities/theatres for the financial year 24/25. True comparisons are often difficult to obtain due to the following factors: -

- Length of session/number of weeks per course
- Size of facilities i.e. sports halls
- What is included in the price e.g. 50+ includes tea and biscuits for GBC
- Membership Packages, and what is included in these packages
- Range of venues for hire e.g. Millennium Suite, theatre, conference facilities
- Eligibility of customers to obtain discounts

There are gaps in some comparative prices, as some authorities do not make comparative provision to those on offer at Gedling.

3.3 Leisure Cards and Concessions

The council currently use a leisure card system to provide discounts to leisure centre users. In addition to the standard leisure card it is possible for customers to qualify for a concessionary leisure card which gives further discounts on leisure activities and memberships. This is currently available for people:

- living with a disability
- in receipt of benefits
- in full time education or
- over the age of 65yrs

The Council also operates a scheme granting care leavers free access to a health and fitness membership up to their 25th birthday.

4 Proposal

4.1 It is proposed that:

a) The fees and charges for Leisure Centres (2024/25) as detailed in Appendix B be introduced from 1st April 2024

Exceptions to this 5% increase:

- Fitness inductions, Boditrax and virtual classes have not increased, this is
 to keep the sessions competitive and to try and move customers towards
 a monthly DNA health and fitness membership.
- Snooker at Richard Herrod has reduced to bring together leisure card holder and concessionary leisure card holders to one price.
- Swimming lessons have increased by more than 5% due to high demand and increasing costs associated with running the pools. The price is still comparable with other local providers
- Some children's parties have gone up by more than 5% to reflect the high demand and investment in new inflatables.
- The cost for a leisure card has increased by more than 5% but is still only a one off annual fee for casual users of the leisure centres
- The removal of the corporate DNA Health and Fitness Membership to ensure residents of the borough are treated fairly, regardless of where they work.
- There has been an increase of £2 per month to the junior DNA Health and Fitness Membership, to bring this in line with local competition
- A new 3 month Active for Life Membership has been created which will be made available to health partners working in the community to help target inactive residents or those living with health conditions. This membership will hopefully create a catalyst for the customers to engage in a healthier lifestyle before moving on to the mainstream DNA Health and Fitness Membership.
- The joining fee for DNA Health and Fitness Membership has not increased for many years, which is why the planned increase is more than 5%
- The movement fee and joining fee for swimming lessons has been frozen, to ensure it remains competitive in the marketplace.
- There has been a decrease in the number of weekend held at the Richard Herrod Centre which also has a direct impact on the income generated through bar drink sales. If an effort to boost the usage of the facility, it is proposed to reduce the cost of the Millennium Suite for functions at peak times by approximately 40%. This will hopefully increase the use of the area which will also increase bar sales.

To boost awareness of the new reduced rates, there will be a marketing campaign designed to appeal to the over 21's age group, in conjunction with Communications Dept.

5 Alternative Options

An alternative percentage increase could be applied; this however may not be effective in producing the required financial improvements for the proposed Medium Term Financial Plan or would increase the leisure prices beyond what is deemed an acceptable increase.

6 Financial Implications

As set out in the General Fund Revenue Budget 2024/25 report approved by on 6th March 2024, the 2024/25 budget is based upon a 5% increase from 1 April 2024. This takes into account inflation and the rising costs associated with delivering services

7 Legal Implications

7.1 The main power to charge for leisure services derives from s.19 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976. This gives the authority the ability to decide whether to charge, and the level of charge for the provision of leisure services. Leisure services continue to be subsidised and an increase in fees to match inflationary pressures is reasonable. Additionally, as Leisure operates commercially, whilst also offering discounts to some service users, application of discretionary increases above or below 5% is reasonable under this charging power.

8 Equalities Implications

8.1 The leisure pricing structure gives discounts to people living with a disability, under the age of 18yrs, over the age of 65yrs or in receipt of certain benefits, and is therefore helping to be inclusive of all. The equality impact assessment can be found in appendix C


