At the old site and along front street been to honiton and they have it along the main street and it's lovely

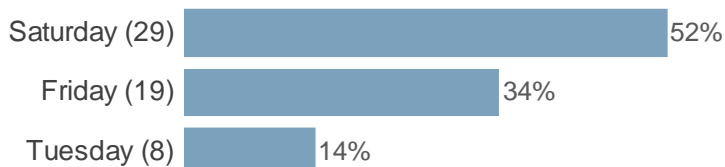

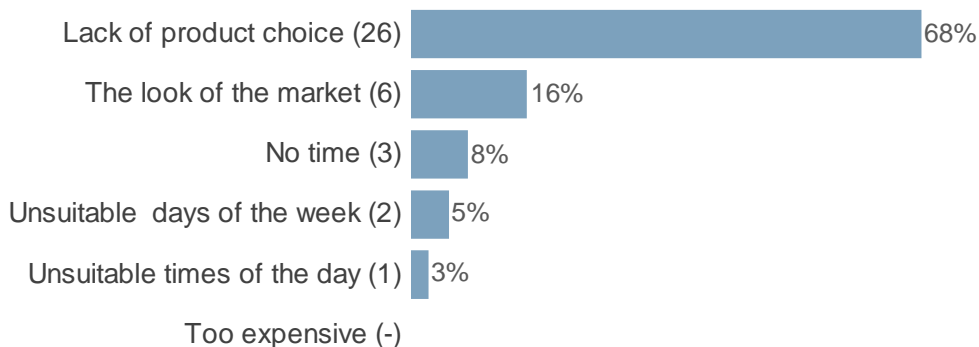

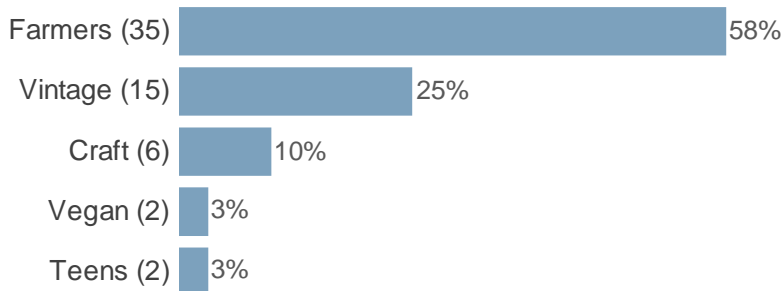

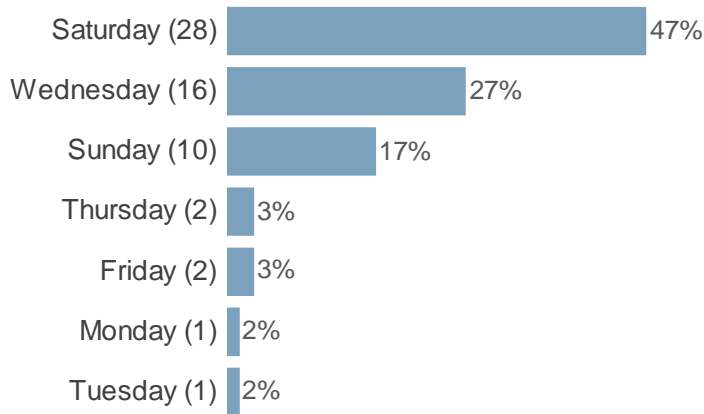
