In The AMP. (You know, Arnold Market Place, the area that had thousands if not millions spent on it to redevelop the market place).

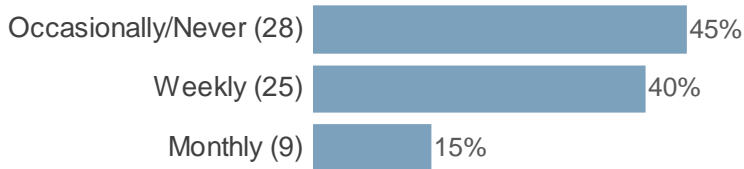

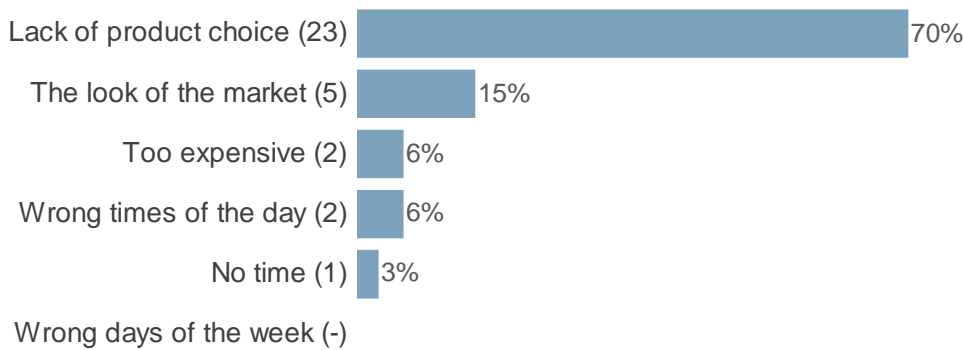
The market place that had millions invested into. The Amp... surely the market place i s'more central and would benefit Arnols in general

How often do you shop at Arnold's Market?



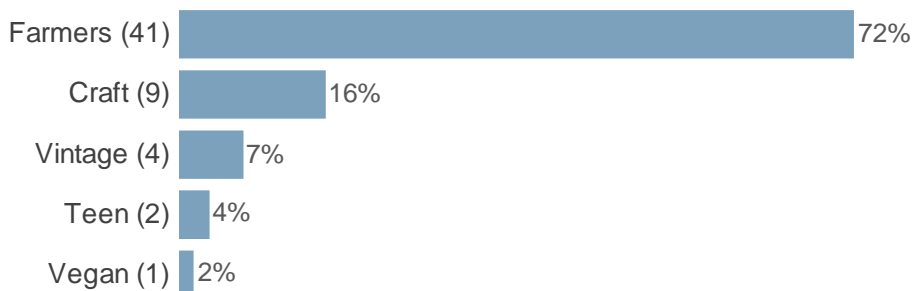
If you do not shop at Arnold General Market, why is this?

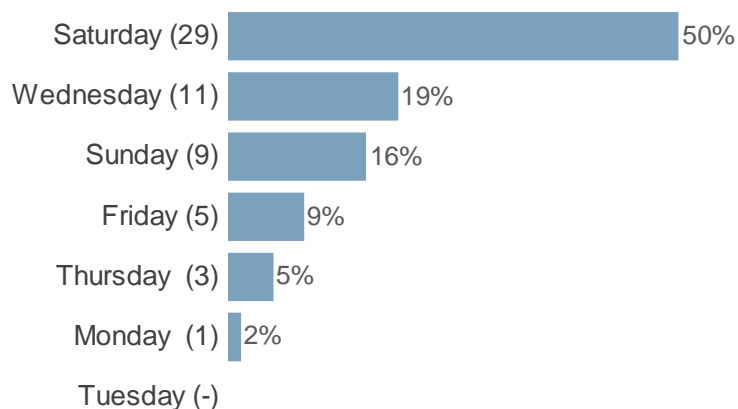

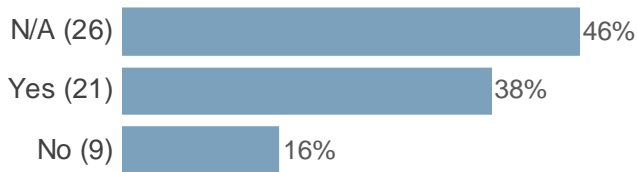

Burger van has already attracted more footfall, need donuts, music and more promotion

It is covering our shops we open in the evening I don't mind the market being there but they should take the stalls off in the evening so people know we exist

If we are having a market, it needs to entice us with great options, the current half dozen stalls don't, I can honestly say I have never been drawn over to browse and never purchased anything from the current stalls. Who uses this present market? none of my family do, and we all live in Arnold and have done all our lives, it offers us very little and it's a shame, and we see other towns like West Bridgford buzzing with people and stalls when they hold their farmers market and it's great, lots of nice quality options and bringing the community together also. Before investing anything, please aim to achieve a different offering than today otherwise it will be the same old same old, looking drab, and offering little not to mention a few hundred thousand pounds less in our council kitty. Investment in Arnold needs to be part of a big picture ambition, it looks and feels like a dying high street, so focusing on a small aspect without the rest seems a little pointless.

Fully British farmers market, crafts and vintage

Sort parking for traders. Permits for roadside parking. More incentives for new traders (ie, cheap rent, etc.)

The access to the Eagle Market via Front Street (Worrall Avenue to High Street) is blocked by far too many cafes and bars without outside furniture. The access to the Market is spoilt by unnecessary clutter of outside seats and barriers.

Eagle Square is quite small for more stalls but the choice is very limited at the moment so not worth travelling just for 2/3 stalls

Having traded on this market occasionally over the last couple of years it needs more publicity and events planned here to show customers that there is another market as some of the traders are original from the old site. The new AMP area should be accommodating these traders.

Just make a decision as to where it is going to be hopefully the one favoured by the stall holders

Be realistic as to what Arnold needs, and not what MPs and councillors want

Need to make it attractive to new stallholders and customers.

Do you have any other comments to make on the Arnold General Market?

The market is very sparse we need some new traders to join. I personally think with it being in eagles square people see it on the way into arnold. But then in AMP it's central and near regular shops etc Maybe if moved into AMP it could do with new stalls etc

Eagle square is the wrong place. AMP is more central and served better for parking, public transport etc

It appears that nothing has been done to make this market better, it should be put back on the original market place, that was the point of having all the new market place done, costing millions of pounds. It is only now that most of the traders have gone that the council wants to do something, there is no incentive for anyone to stand on this market, why can't any traders stand here, craft, farmers, second hand etc stand together, it would make the market look so much busier and interesting. I just think now it's too late for the market.

We need to have more up market stalls and less tat. There's a man selling videos and tatty old paperback books!! Nobody uses VHS anymore. We should encourage diversity and local business's to hold stalls. Street foods/produce stalls from all different races and religions. More craft stalls. Themed days and markets to celebrate occasions such as Christmas or a Valentines day market. Buskers. Hot drinks stall. People need a reason to come to Arnold and a bustling modern market is just the thing.

More free car parking Lower rents to increase business Not vape shops or money laundering barbers
