Environmental Protection Act 1990 Section 80

A Notice was served on the residents of a property in Belvoir Lodge, Whimsey Park Carlton on 21st May 2013, to prevent an accumulation of domestic refuge and furniture at the side of the property.

A Notice was served on the occupier of a property in Dunstan Street, Netherfield to prevent the accumulation of domestic refuse and furniture at the property.

<u>Health & Safety at Work Etc Act 1974 Section 2(1) and the Workplace (Health, Safety and Welfare) Regulations 1992 Regulation 12(1)</u>

An Improvement Notice was served on a property in the Burntstump Country Park, to improve the flooring of a food storage area, preventing risk to staff, health and safety.

<u>Health & Safety at Work Etc Act 1974 Section 2(1) and 3(1) the Workplace (Health, Safety and Welfare) Regulations 1992 Regulation 5(1)</u>

An improvement Notice was served on the owner of a property on Main Road Gedling, to improve and maintain the workplace, of a wooden storage shed in the rear service yard that has been struck by a vehicle, breaking and dislodging the support frame. The structure is unstable.

Environmental Protection Act 1990 sections 87 and 88

Under the above legislation it is an offence if any person throws down, drops or otherwise deposits litter on any public land. The Act also enables the local Authority to operate a fixed penalty scheme whereby the offender may be given the option for paying a fixed penalty within 14 days and so discharge any liability of conviction for that offence by the Court. The current level of fixed penalty is £50.00.
