Subject: Gedling Gambling Statement of Principles

Purpose of Report

To inform Members of the progress made producing the new Gedling Gambling Statement of Principles and to refer the policy to full Council to adopt the new Gambling Statement.

Information

The Gambling Act 2005 requires Licensing Authorities to prepare and publish at least every three years a statement of the principles that they propose to apply when exercising their gambling functions. The existing Gambling Statement for this Authority is coming up for renewal by the end of 2015. Officers have carried out statutory consultation of the draft new statement with bodies and organisations representing the trade, the Gambling Commission and Responsible Authorities under the Act including the Chief Constable, HM Revenues and Customs and the Nottinghamshire Safeguarding Children Board.

One response was received from a betting company in support of the document and the changes.

The changes to the existing statement are minor as follows:
